

Recycling Locations & Info for Meadowbrook Elementary

1. Return-It Express Depot

This program allows you to drop off the containers at a Return-It Express kiosk without having to sort them first. They take care of the sorting and credit the deposit refunds to the consumer's online account. Then, the consumer can turn those refunds into cash, gift cards, or a charitable donation.

The schools' online account is registered under the school's phone number **604-464-5813**.

How it works:

1. With Return-It Express there's no need to sort. Simply place your empty beverage containers securely into a "Blue" or transparent bag.
2. Visit a Return-It Express kiosk at one of the locations listed and use your registered phone number to access your account.
3. Select how many bags you have and where you want us to deposit your refund. You can either choose your account or select one of the charities listed on the screen.
4. Once you've finished, the kiosk will print off labels for you to stick on each bag. It's important each bag receives it's own sticker.
5. Place your bags into the Express Kiosk drop off area and you are done. We'll sort, count and refund your deposit. It's that simple.

2. Biggar Bottle Depot

We are also registered at the Biggar Bottle Depot at 2275 Kingsway Ave, Port Coquitlam, BC V3C 1T5. Just down the road from school. <https://www.return-it.ca/locations/biggar-bottle-depot/> At this location you have to sort out the bottles yourself. Let the customer services representative know that you'd like to add the \$\$\$ to Meadowbrook Elementary account. They track the funds "old school-on paper".
